Repentigny, August 27th 2019 – This 34th edition of the tournament provided its share of upsets right from the start, on center court, as many seeded players were eliminated by opponents coming out of the qualifying round. And things are looking good for the remainder of the tournament, which promises to be more exciting!

On the girls side

The day's first matchup was highlighted by Canadian Marina Stakusic's victory against 5th seed Kamilla Bartone, of Latvia, 3-6, 6-4, 6-1.

Ontario's Ariana Arsenault will be up against the tournament's top seed Natsumi Kawaguchi, of Japan, in 3rd round action. Kawaguchi triumphed on center court against French player Aubane Droguet, 7-5, 6-4. Kawaguchi's service, consistency and attitude all proved her first seed ranking in the tournament to be worthy.

On the boys side

First seed Harold Mayot's (FRA) path came to an end as he bowed 7-6, 6-2 to American Alexander Bernard, who came straight out of the qualifying round. The young American will face Swiss Leandro Riedi in a 3rd round clash.

Flavio Cobolli (ITA), seeded 5th, also had an abrupt end when he got defeated by British Arthur Fery, 4-6, 6-1, 6-4. Laval's Taha Baadi couldn't overcome Italian Francesco Maestrelli who beat the crowd favourite, 6-2, 6-3.

On the slate tomorrow

Canadian Joshua Lapadat, after defeating 2nd seed Emilio Nava in second round play, will be up against Italian Luciano Darder; all hopes are legitimate for Lapadat who until now has had an exceptional tournament. Also highlighting the day, the match between Belgian Gauthier Onclin (3) and Frenchman Artur Cazaux. On the girls side, Sada Nahimana (3) will face Liubov Kostenko; two great matches are in perspective.
