Qualifiers Set for the Main Draw

Repentigny, August 28, 2026 – Five Canadians from the 19-player delegation successfully qualified for the main draw. The 39th edition of the National Bank Junior Tennis Internationaux officially gets underway this Saturday and runs through Friday, September 4, at Parc Larochelle in Repentigny.

Boys' Qualifying

Top qualifying seed Loic Massotte won his match 6-3, 6-1 against Montreal's Yanis Roch. His twin brother, Xavier, continues to make strides and has established himself as one of the young Canadian players to watch in the main draw.

Two Quebec players faced off in the second round, with 11th seed Filip Vujicic taking on second seed Aaron-David Mefire Younzwé. Vujicic won the match 6-4, 6-0.

Third seed Brayden Woo secured his place in the main draw by defeating Montreal's Hayden Majumdar-Moreau in straight sets, 7-6 (5), 6-3.

Ontario native Ranak Pajpani defeated 10th-seeded Pierre-Olivier Hay of Montreal in straight sets, 6-4, 6-0.

Ontario's Kye McDadi, the fifth seed, recorded a victory over ninth-seeded American Syed Sulaiman by a score of 6-7, 2-7, 2-6.

Girls' Qualifying

Quebec's Laurence Demers was the only player among the 12 members of the Canadian delegation to earn a spot in the main draw. The Boischatel native defeated seventh-seeded Dongchen King of China 6-4, 7-5.

The first main-draw matches begin at 9 a.m. tomorrow, Saturday, August 29, at Parc Larochelle in Repentigny. In the event of rain, matches may be moved indoors to the
