Andrea Cabio Advances to the Singles Semifinals

Repentigny, September 2, 2026 – Canadian Andrea Cabio continues to surprise as she advances through the main draw. In the quarterfinals, she defeated Serbia's Masa Janković, who had eliminated top seed Ksenia Efremova in the third round.

A closer look at the 17-year-old Ontarian's run shows that she continues to make the most of this week's opportunity to improve her international junior ranking. Starting in the second round, she earned victories over seeded players Siyoen Sim (USA) [11] and Ilary Pistola (ITA) [5]. In the quarterfinals, she defeated Serbia's Masa Janković in straight sets, 7-6, 6-2. In the semifinals, she will face 15-year-old British player Daniella Britton [6].

On Centre Court

In the quarterfinals, the next match featured Valentin Gonzalez-Galino [14] against Mark Ceban (GBR) [5]. The Briton won the match in three sets, 6-4, 3-6, 6-4.

In the semifinals, Ceban will face American Marcel Latak, who defeated Rihards Neimanis (LAT) [16] in the third round and Italy's Simone Massellani [6] in the quarterfinals. The other semifinal will feature Kai Thompson (HKG) [7] against Rhys Lawlor (GBR) [15].

Rain Forces Play Indoors

Early in the evening, the featured match that was scheduled to take place on Centre Court at Parc Larochelle between Hollie Smart (GBR) [9] and Renee Alame (AUS) [2] was moved indoors to the Centre récréatif de Repentigny due to rain.

Since the beginning of the tournament, Smart had faced opponents who were not among the seeded players. A closer match was therefore expected against Alame, who battled for more than three hours Tuesday evening in her third-round match against American Carrie-Anne Hoo, the 2025 tournament doubles champion.

Smart ultimately won the closely contested match in straight sets, 6-4, 7-5. In the semifinals, she will face fourth seed Antonina Sushkova of Ukraine.
